USWAG is pleased to announce its 2023 SPCC Workshop. This workshop features two days of content that will be applicable to both experienced environmental professionals and those new to the Spill Prevention, Control, and Countermeasure (SPCC) and Facility Response Program (FRP) requirements.

During Day 1 of the USWAG SPCC Workshop, attendees will be provided a basic overview of the SPCC and FRP requirements, led by two veteran U.S. EPA subject matter experts. Day 1 will conclude with an hour-long open question answer session with EPA. Join us in the evening for a Networking Reception.

Day 2 of USWAG's SPCC Workshop is focused upon the practical application of the SPCC and FRP programs and will kick-off with a presentation by EPA on what to expect during an EPA SPCC inspection and a review of common observations that EPA staff have noted regarding the implementation of the SPCC requirements. Later in the morning EPA will provide a presentation on the practical implementation of the FRP program requirements. After lunch on Day 2 we will have a speaker from EPRI and a session with multiple case studies presented by USWAG member companies.
